## 5. Housing Development Committee

**5.1 Review and Consultation on New Mexico Finance Authority Rules Governing the Administration of Housing Development Revolving Fund Loans.** Staff presented the draft rules governing the Opportunity Enterprise Housing Development Program. Staff is solicitating feedback from the Housing Review Committee and then the full Opportunity Enterprise Housing Development Board on the Policy. Staff will incorporate any comments to the final policy.

**6.1 Demonstration of Online Application.** Staff presented a demonstration of the application to the Board members summarizing the client's experience filling out an online application. Key features include eligibility determination, project description, staff reviewing process, FAQs, and confidentiality.

**6.2** Consideration of the Timelines for the Opportunity Enterprise Application Periods and Amounts Available under First Application for Housing Development Assistance. Staff presented the recommended timeline for the application period and funding amounts for the housing development assistance.

Staff recommends opening the application on September 4, 2024, and making available \$30 million for the first-round closing on October 16, 2024. This first round will allow Staff to evaluate the policies upon its conclusion and make any changes before the next two rounds, anticipated to be in early 2025. This will provide for time to conduct statewide outreach to reach out to interested parties who may not have heard of the programs and completing their plans for future developments.

Staff recommends approval of the Housing Development Project Application and Opening Rounds timelines as proposed.
